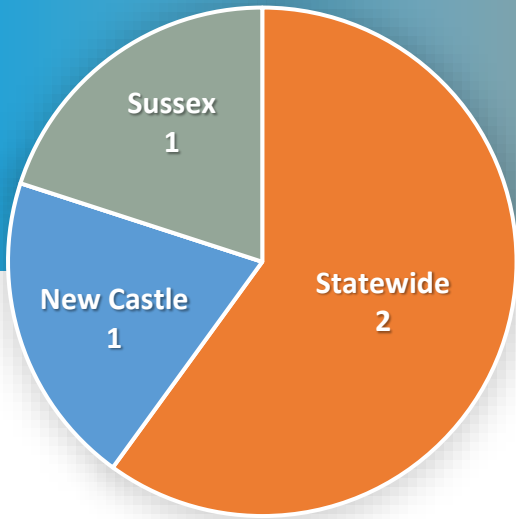


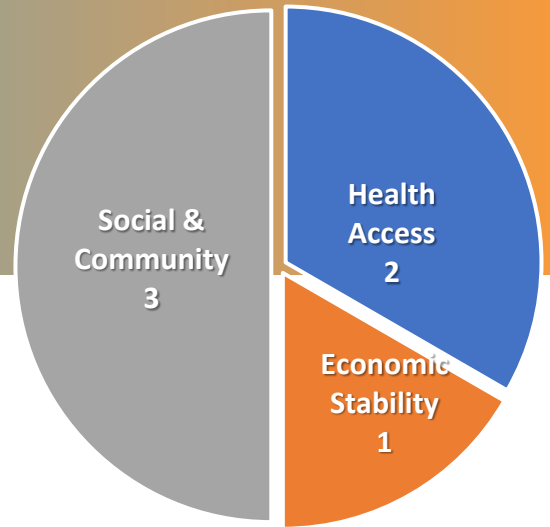

Brief Program Descriptions

La Red Health Center

The Rural Re-entry program will support individuals transitioning out of incarceration systems and into the community. The program will address the healthcare needs and social determinants of health of these individuals to promote successful reintegration and improve overall well-being. The goal of the program would be to prevent recidivism, reduce overdose deaths in our state and the prevent homelessness.

Camp Sunshine

Camp Sunshine provides hope, joy and community through 4-5 day-long experiences for children and young adults (up to age 20) with life-threatening illnesses and their families. When a child faces serious illness, it impacts every family member (parents/caregivers, ill child and siblings).

Brief Program Descriptions

Limen House

Limen's new Recovery Community Center (RCC). The RCC will accommodate an additional 1000 patients annually and include services such as Level 3.1 care, 24/7, programming and screening to IOP, outpatient, sober living program, treatment center, and alumni programming.

City of Wilmington, DE

The program is tailored to benefit the residents of Wilmington, recognizing that wellness is contagious and that a healthier Wilmington contributes to a healthier Delaware. All are encouraged to participate in a range of events, predominantly hosted within Wilmington. ONE HEART encompasses an array of one-time and recurring events designed to promote holistic well-being.
